<sup>29</sup> Suddenly a strong earthquake struck, and the Lord's angel came down from heaven. He rolled away the stone and sat on it. <sup>30</sup> The angel looked as bright as lightning, and his clothes were white as snow. <sup>31</sup> The women shook, from fear and fell down, as though they were dead.

<sup>32</sup> The angel said to the women, "Don't be afraid! I know you are looking for Jesus, who was nailed to a cross."

<sup>33</sup> He isn't here! God has raised him to life, just as Jesus said he would. Come, see the place where his body was lying. Now hurry! Tell his disciples that he has been raised to life and is on his way to Galilee. Go there, and you will see him. That is what I came to tell you."



### Higher than the Clouds


Genesis 11:1-9


### The Battle Won with Trumpets

Peter put one foot over the side. It went down, down, down, then stopped. Then he


strung his second leg over and stood up. He did not sink!


Jesus reached out His hand. He grabbed Peter. Jesus said, "Oh Peter, Peter! Where is your faith? Why did you doubt?"


## King Belshazzar's Banquet
